Joint Meeting November 20, 2019

Minutes

Gary Scholl, BAC Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:30.

Attendees:

Fire Department:

Chief Clark reviewed expenditures to date and anticipated costs for 2020. See his prepared chart attached. Currently 2019 shows a \$7000 surplus but a WD Perkins bill for \$4000 was charged to another department and will be corrected by year end. Additionally the "new" truck heeds tires which will be purchased by yearend.

No monies will be requested for the repairs and maintenance reserve in 2020.

It was agreed that dues could be lowered to \$2100 and training lowered to \$3000.

The disposition of the old truck was discussed and it was agreed that there should be a warrant article at town meeting to deposit any proceeds of the sale into the reserve for fire department maintenance.

It was clarified that account #1620 is the one that should be used for repair and maintenance. The replacement of the thermal imager is scheduled for 2020 and will be a \$6880 warrant article. The availability of auxiliary funds to cover this expense was discussed and a request will be made.

The Fire Department was congratulated for securing the "new" truck. Its replacement has been pushed "off the end of the CIP schedule".

Library:

Kathy Fedorka discussed 2019 expenditures to date and needs for 2020. No handout was submitted.

The telephone is costing \$140 per month. Kathy will investigate.

Mileage has increased due to more trips to Peterborough to pick up books on loan from the State.

Miscellaneous expenses include costs of "prizes" for young readers and passes to the Science Center and the Canterbury Shaker Village. Usage of the library was described as "up" particularly among new young families in town.

The wage line for assistants is down due to a higher paid individual being unable to work as many hours as usual. Lower paid individuals are filling in.

Early in 2019 a water pipe froze and was fixed.

Replacement of the furnace is in the CIP for 2021. It makes noise now (fan plus vibration) which could be fixed for \$1500 under Repairs and Maintenance.

Exterior painting above the east door should be done in 2020. Perhaps this could be done when the rails on the common are painted.

The books expense line is substantially below budget. Some of this was explained by books ordered costing a few dollars less each than in the past. It was not clear what the majority of the difference could be attributed to. Buying books at a discount through Amazon was discussed but Fedorka thought inappropriate due to complexity of ordering/tracking and billing. Fedorka thought books could be reduced by \$1000 without any impact.

Fedorka has cut back on some magazines which weren't being read. This line could be reduced by \$300.

Dues and subscriptions includes classes taken by staff. They haven't done in recent years but perhaps will in 2020. Fedorka recommends leaving the budget as is.

Cam Lockwood suggested that Library staff receive a 3% increase in 2020. Chairman Scholl explained that the BAC does not address salaries/wages. Christine Robidoux explained the independence of the Library from the Town budget process.

Animal Control:

Jen Rheume discussed her services to the Town. A report regarding call volumes has been submitted to the Select Board and will be requested.

The new kennel is working well. Fill was brought in to prevent dogs from escaping and an invoice has been submitted to the Town but has not yet been recorded.

A proposal to charge horse owners \$25 for each animal rounded up was suggested years ago but apparently never adopted. It was agreed that this is not an urgent issue because there have not been many escapes.

It is important to keep the \$550 in miscellaneous expenses as this is the cost of Jen receiving rabies shots should she be bitten.

Supervisors of the Checklist:

Mary Amsden presented a detailed summary of her anticipated expenses for 2020 given that there are three elections plus the ConVal meeting. Total anticipated wages are \$2104.25. See attached summary.

Mary confirmed that they only have as many supervisors present during voter enrollment and attending voting as are required by the State.

Printing and advertising should be set at \$300 which was the budget in 2016 when NH last had three elections.

Mary does not anticipate purchasing any supplies that she cannot get from the Town office so that line should remain at \$1.

Welfare:

Chair Scholl summarized conversations with the welfare officer. It is anticipated that there will be little to no surplus in that line item and that the BAC should therefore keep that line item for 2020 as is.

ConComm:

Robidoux and Kieley met with the Commission and it was agreed to leave as is for 2020.

ZBA:

Kieley suggested leaving as is for 2020.

Tax Rate:

The recent work on the tax rate was discussed including the recommendation to the SB that \$103,000 from fund balance be used resulting in a \$22.58 rate.

The concept of developing a fund balance policy was discussed including the collection of policies from about a dozen towns. Kieley to develop a draft policy for the BAC's consideration with a target date of Town Meeting for project completion.

SWRPC Road Study:

Gail is chasing them. Target to meet on December 11 at 4:30.

Road Paving:

Tedd brought up some of the complications of moving from a budget line item to a warrant article. If the funds are in the budget the SB has more flexibility to move monies around. Tim Fiske confirmed that there would not be monies coming out of the Highway trust fund in 2019.

Miscellaneous:

Tim reported that the heated walkway isn't working and that Pinney will come this year to fix. Kent reported that the grave stone repair project is complete ahead of schedule and below budget. Funds need to be requested of the Cemetery Trustees for their share of 2019 cost. No budget needs to be established for this expense in 2020.

New revenue and expense lines need to be set up for grave digging. Final fees need to be confirmed. An expense budget needs to be established.

The BAC minutes of November 5 were discussed and the minutes modified. Motion by Kieley second by Cromwell to accept the minutes as amended. Unanimously approved.

Motion to adjourn at 6:21 by Kieley second by Cromwell. Unanimously approved.
