TEMPLE CONSERVATION COMMISSION Minutes, May 10, 2017 Location: Chris Weston Conservation Area

Route 45 Properties: As planned, the Temple Conservation Commission had a hike/outing to explore the property line of the town owned Rt 45 properties north of town. After gathering at town hall, members drove to the Chris Weston Conservation Area. The group walked south on Rt 45 to the southernmost boundary of the town owned Rt 45 properties. Then the group walked in from the road, along rock wall bisecting lot 2-75-1 (town owned) and lot 2-77 (privately owned). The group followed the rock wall to the rock wall intersection of 2-75-1, 2-77, 2-74 and larger parcel.

Once at the intersection, the group noted the Monadnock conservancy tags on western parcels and then travelled north on rock wall in effort to traverse the back (western) boundary of the town owned Rt 45 properties.

The terrain was steep, rising east to west as well as rising north. There was steep decline east of the rock wall.

After some time, the group had the impression following the rock wall was taking them farther from the Rt 45. The started moving north east away from the rock wall in effort to reconnect with Rt 45. As they descended, they were able to see roof of the buildings of the property between the town owned Rt 45 properties (the former Amma center "MA center"). The group approached Rt 45 near the north west corner of the clearing of parcel 2-75-3.

The group discussed next steps. *Cathy Joly would research owners of properties west ('behind') the Rt 45 properties.* Sean Radcliffe would rewalk the stone wall with GPS to track visible relation to the road. Adie Krullis offered a graphic arts resource to assist with merging tax maps and google maps.

The group decided to not attempt to have a conventional meeting because of the time.

The group adjourned by 8:15 pm. Next meeting will be Wednesday, June 14th, 2017
