

The Renewable Energy Task Force will meet remotely via Zoom on Monday, May 18, at 7 PM.

The Agenda will be:

1. A short discussion regarding having Temple join many other NH towns and Energy Committees in signing-on to the letter sent from Clean Energy NH encouraging our state legislators and Governor Sununu to support legislation extending the cap for net-metered projects in NH towns – with BOS approval.
2. A discussion focused on the information presented to the Task Force by Henry Herndon, Director of Local Solutions at Clean Energy NH, at our previous meeting on April 27.

The discussion will review:

- a. The benefits of presenting the option of establishing a Community Power plan for the electricity needs of Temple's residents and businesses at the next Town Meeting.
- b. Various options for its potential structure, including whether to create our town's own CP program, independent of the opportunities to join with other towns in larger group bulk purchasing programs.
- c. Whether to become actively involved in the planning and coordination of the state-wide umbrella organization for CP in NH.
- d. Where the potential solar array plans for municipal energy stand now, given the economic stresses predicted for the near term.
