Public Comment:

- After hearing about Peterborough's recent cyber-attack, Kerry McDonald inquired about Temple's cyber security. Ezell informed McDonald that Temple has policies and procedures in place to avoid such an event.
- Robidoux asked why some of the COVID hospital updates that were forwarded to the webmaster are not appearing on the town's website. Ezell responded that the webmaster had asked him about posting redundant material and he approved not posting some material. After additional discussion, the board agreed to verify the validity of the material in the future and if legitimate and informative, they will instruct the webmaster to post the material on the website.
