

Actions YOU Can Take

1. **Go to the website www.nhpipelineawareness.org** and learn about this pipeline proposal. Click on “Take Action” for a list of helpful steps you can take.
2. **Sign the petition to Gov Hassan on the website above.**
3. Write letters or make phone calls to our legislators stating your opposition to the NED pipeline - the website will give you a list of contacts.
4. **Take photos of any eagles you see near the reservoir, school, or SCAT land, Or a wood turtle—near streams, wetlands, etc. Rough brownish shell and head, orange coloring underneath and on legs, 5-9” long.**
5. **Put a NO pipeline sign up on your property.**
6. **Write a letter to the editor for the Transcript, Keene Sentinel, etc.**
7. **Talk to your friends and connections in social media and explain that there is no more energy crisis & prices will rise if NED is approved rather than dropping.**
8. Help organize a fund-raising event for legal fees to support our efforts.
9. Join the fund-raising effort through leasing solar panels on your roof, paying no more than your normal electricity bills. Email Bev for details.
