NH House Bills

Our physical presence makes a huge difference, whether we speak or not. We will have “No Pipeline” badges if you don't have one. Writing or calling has an impact as well.

WHAT: **Please support House Bill 1660 regarding eminent domain and HB 1148 re: not allowing long term contracts for space on the pipeline. Please write or call our senators or COME to the State House!!** After you have made your calls, you can also call your state House reps and urge them to contact them as well.

WHEN: **Wednesday April 13, 2016 9:30 am for HB 1660 and 10:00 am for HB 1148**

WHERE: **NH State House Room 100 (or call/ write beforehand). Speak or just bring your presence. PLEASE COME TO THE STATE HOUSE if you can or at least call or write!!!**

HOW: **Share these messages with our NH Senators (see below) by writing, calling or sharing in person** ... Please feel free to use your own words. But this can get you started:

“I support House Bill 1660 because I want property owners to be more justly compensated. Locating a high pressure industrialized pipeline can damage a property's value. Therefore I want affected property owners to have the right and opportunity to tell a pipeline company like Kinder Morgan (or others), that if the property is to be taken by eminent domain that the property owner can say, “Take all of my land, not just a right of way, with full appropriate compensation.”

“I also support House Bill 1148 because I do not want utilities to be able to secure long term contracts with pipeline companies for more than a year. Because the natural (methane) gas markets are quite volatile and changing, long term contracts can lock us into prices for energy that could ultimately prove higher than what the market is offering in a given year. Further, long term contracts for methane gas can: force us into supporting financially and environmentally expensive and harmful processes like fracking; move us away from investing financial resources into renewable energy at a time when climate issues are of great concern; and put us far from the goal of the NH Energy Plan which calls for diversification of energy resources and away from the dangerous situation of having all our ‘eggs’ in the methane ‘basket’. Please support HB 1148.”

PLEASE CALL THESE SENATORS! AND ... IF YOU KNOW FAMILY OR FRIENDS IN THESE TOWNS, PLEASE ASK THEM TO CALL AS WELL – and COME TO THE STATE HOUSE IF YOU CAN!!

HB 1148 (Relative to Pipeline Capacity Contracts) and HB 1660 (Relative to eminent domain for gas pipelines) have been referred to the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee.
