Minutes of the February 14th meeting were approved.

UNH books on food sufficiency and farm sustainability in New England: Members discussed a mailing from John Carroll, Professor of Environmental Conservation at UNH, about his three books on New England food, farm, and conservation issues. Bruce said he had talked with John about his books at a recent conference, and he recommended them to the TCC.

John Kieley moved, and Lincoln Geiger seconded, that Bruce spend up to \$70 of TCC funds for the purchase of John Carroll's three books for the Temple Library. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Consideration of John Kieley and Bruce Kantner for reappointment to the TCC for threeyear terms: Honey Hastings moved, and Lincoln Geiger seconded, that the TCC recommend to the Select Board the reappointment of John Kieley and Bruce Kantner for three-year terms on the Temple Conservation Commission. The vote was unanimous in favor.
