Town of Temple Covid-19 Policies

The select board has established policies to guide our response to the Covid-19 issue. As we and the state begin to reopen, some policies remain in place, some have changed. For all policies, we follow the state orders and recommendations and also follow requirements from the town's insurance provider, Primex. We do this to not only protect the townspeople, but to protect the town itself from potential lawsuits.

Here are the current policies, this document will be updated as changes are made.

- 1) Town buildings remain closed to the public.
- 2) Town properties such as the ball field, tennis courts, playground, and common remain closed. Any use is a violation of town policies.
- 3) Limited use of the town common can be made. Any use is by select board approval, and the use must follow the current state guidelines. Proof of insurance that protects the town from any Covid-19 liability could be required, depending upon the activity.
- 4) The library is working on plans to provide limited access to some services, their policies will be posted as soon as available.

The select board will be having special meetings to plan our future policies. These meetings will be posted and participation by departments, committees, commissions, and the public is encouraged. The select board will also be discussing policies and issues in our regular meetings, check the agendas.

The select board greatly appreciates the efforts of all residents to stay safe during this challenging time. Please continue to observe social distancing, wear a mask in public, and wash your hands often. Remember, while infection might not be serious for a 30-yr-old, that person can spread it to someone that could become critically ill or die.
