The Recreation Commission requests to hold their annual July 4 Patriotic Bike Parade on Saturday July 4 at 3 PM. We propose to hold this event at the town center with the parade route starting in front of the Town Hall and circling around the Memorial Tree in front of the church; continuing back up Rte 45 past the Common and entering the driveway to the church by the Memorial Tree circling back again. Time will be taken at the beginning to organize individuals and groups allowing adequate social distancing between them with the parade set to commence by 3:15 PM.

Support help from several community volunteers, the TVFD, and committee members will assist and ensure that best practices of social distance as required by the town are upheld. Disposable face masks, latex gloves, sanitary wipes and hand disinfectant will be available to ALL participants to encourage their use as recommended by the CDC and other health agencies and our town officials.

For festivity and viewing enjoyment the parade will go several times around. The length of time for the parade to last will be 20 to 30 minutes at the longest. Participants will receive a recognition ribbon as the Rec Cmsn has done in past years. Bottled water will be available as well.

The Recreation Commission would like to encourage participation of families and plans to provide decorations that people can pick up at the Temple Store on Thursday July 2nd and Friday July 3rd during store hours.

Any amendment as decided by the Select Board to this proposal will be heeded by the Recreation Commission.
