Census Blocks are statistical areas bounded on all sides by visible features, such as streets, roads, streams, and railroad tracks, and/or by nonvisible boundaries such as city town township and county limits and GREENFIELD such as city, town, township, and county limits, and short line-of-sight extensions of streets and roads. Temple tax parcels (dated 2007), much smaller in TEMPLE Pettingill Hill Rd size than Census blocks, have been added to the **Housing Units** According to the Census Byreau, a housing unit is a house, an aparticipt, a nobile home, a group of rooms, or a single floor that is occupied (or if the vacant, is intended for occupancy) as separate on living quarters. Separate living quarters are those in which the occupants live and eat separately from any other persons in the building and which have direct access from the outside of the building or Oak Hill through a common hall.
