Dear Residents:

The Temple Select Board is taking the following action to help mitigate the spread of Coronavirus. The following actions will be effective immediately and in place until further notice.

Effective March 17th, 2020:

- The Town Hall, including Annex meeting rooms, is closed - No exceptions.
- The Town Library has been closed per Library Trustees.
- The Recreation Committee has cancelled all programs.
- Chairs of all Town Boards and Committees are instructed to cancel in-person meetings. Per the Right-to Know law, all meetings of a public body must still be open to the public and still require public notice. All Boards & Committee are required to use conference calls or other electronic means that comply with the state Right-to-Know law. Further instruction will be sent to Committee and Board Chairs.
- Access to the Town Garage and inner Town offices will be limited to employees only.
- If you have business with the Town Clerk or Tax Collector consider whether it can be handled over the phone or deferred. If it is necessary to come in, please wash your hands carefully before coming and use the wipes provided at the counter. If you are feeling ill do not come into the office.
- There will be no group gatherings on Town owned land.

We are in a very fluid situation so expect modifications to the above.
