Minutes of the Public Meeting in Temple

November 1, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm by Chair Bill Ezell of Temple. By order of roll call vote, in attendance were Bill Ezell and Ken Caisse of Temple, Maggie Bickford and Doug Reardon of Greenville, Chief McTague and Deb Morrison.

Minutes

Doug Reardon made a motion to accept the minutes for the October 4 meeting. Ken Caisse seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

The heating oil prices have been locked in and it was decided to up the budget for cruiser fuel.

New Business

Bill said people are complaining about parking in town, for example, around the Birchwood, and will be a problem this winter. Discussion followed about putting out flyers reminding people of the parking ban, which will be enforced. Greenville has a parking ordinance and Temple may need to adopt something similar. This does not have to be done at town meeting.

Chief's Report

Chief said he stripped out the old cruiser. He initially wanted to sell it for \$1,500, however, the lock on the front driver's door is broken and won't stay shut. The new cruiser is here and he's organizing having the new lights installed.

Asplundh and the cable company are in Temple now and the water project is being completed on Rte. 31 and Pleasant St. in Greenville.

Chief said it was exceptionally quiet for Halloween in Greenville. Temple had a map available for house-to-house trick or treating.

At the end of the year the Chief said he'll do a uniform check with the officers to see what they may need.
