3. Plans for Flowers:

- Lori and Mackenzie will purchase flowers for the boxes/planters which will include a variety of red, white and blue flowers, including geraniums, as well as some greenery.
- We plan to plant the flowers sometime before Memorial Day
- Anne offered to donate a Begonia plant that she has currently in a planter. We will decide on the best location for this at our next meeting.
- We went to look at the stone to the right of the common fencing, across from the Temple Store. There hole inside the stone accumulates water. We decided that we may put a planter or two with flowers inside this hole.
